- API & Plugin Updates This includes updates to JAVA OpenJDK 11, MySQL 8.0.16, Windows Server 2019, full 64-bit support and additional REST APIs. These updates provide support for customer's current servers, databases and related systems.

- Multiple Server Support A new drop-down menu allows users to manage multiple automation servers from a single interface without having to log in to each server individually in separate sessions. This will save time and make administration more efficient.
- Permission Configuration A new simple interface for defining resource groups allows users to view and manage user group access to resource groups. This supports any Windows or domain (AD) user group name and simplifies user and group management.
- Plugin Updates This includes updates to MySQL 8.0.16 and Windows Server 2019.
